Background and project objectives:

Vegetable production may provide significant benefits to farmland birds over and above those provided by dominant arable crops like wheat and rape. This project proposes to use national data on breeding bird abundance and population trends and data on horticultural cropping to examine whether such benefits can be detected at a national scale. Recommendations will then be produced as to how such benefits can be maximized further.
