Background and project objectives

This project aims to provide UK vegetable growers with detailed information about biopesticides and their potential for use as part of robust integrated crop protection protocols that support vegetable production systems. This information would be used to develop policies on biopesticides and strategies to streamline the registration and marketing of the products needed by growers.

To achieve these aims there will be liaison with key crop associations (discussions and meetings) plus the relevant trade associations and supermarkets. In addition, it will be important to link with UK and European regulators, and biopesticide companies to ascertain product availability and ways to encourage increased product availability in the UK.
